LEGISLATION

1. Third reading – Ord - Authorizing the Mayor to enter into an easement agreement with the Atomic Credit Union.
2. Third reading – Ord - Appropriating funds in the amount of \$10,000.00 for use by the Fire Department for vehicle repair and fuel usage for the remainder of 2019.
3. Secomd reading – Ord - Suspending the maximum hours established for one part-time security officer and one part-time deputy bailiff to allow for their services for the remainder of 2019.
4. First reading – Ord - Appropriating funds in the amount of \$1,124,000.00 for the purpose of making payroll and fringes for the remainder of 2019.
5. First reading – Ord - Appropriating funds for various end-of-year expenses, transferring funds to reimburse Parks & Recreation for telephone bills paid on behalf of the Police Department.
6. First reading – Ord - Accepting and appropriating \$4,942.65 received as payoff of a CHIP mortgage.
7. First reading – Ord - Transferring funds within the Law Director's 2019 budget to cover costs related to moving the Law Director's Office to City owned property at 26 South Paint Street.
8. First reading – Ord - Accepting and appropriating \$32,037.74 in insurance funds received for the repair of damaged traffic signals and appropriating funds to cover the deductible and other costs related to the repair.
9. First reading – Ord - Authorizing the issuance of not to exceed \$220,000.00 Building Acquisition and Improvement Bonds for the purpose of building acquisition and improvement, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto.
10. First reading – Ord - Consolidating three bond issues of the City of Chillicothe, Ohio.
11. First reading – Res - Approving the installation of wafaring signs in the Historical District and the placement of directional kiosks in the municipal parking lots.
